



Post Season Play-off Guidelines

- Only number 1 or 2 rated officials will be considered for assignment to post season play. (End of season ratings to be furnished to play-off assignment Committee by rating Committee chairperson)
- Any official being considered for post season assignment MUST have officiated a MINIMUM of EIGHT regular season games, and must have participated in at least one pre-season scrimmage and/or clinic sponsored by NCOA. Clinics and scrimmages are NOT to be considered as regular season games.
- Official must be in good standing with the association. (See by-law definition)
- Official must have taken the classification exam administered by the instructional committee, and received a score of 80 or higher. Any official NOT scoring 80 or higher on this exam, WILL NOT be considered for post season assignment.
- Official must have attended/participated in 2/3 of the scheduled instructional classroom sessions and general meetings.
- When considering any official for post season assignment, the play-off assignment committee will consider any beg-offs and games turned back by that official.
- When considering any official for post season assignment, the play-off assignment committee will consider that official's overall participation in the association, especially his or her PARTICIPATION in the evaluating process when working two person regular season game assignments.
- The play-off assignment committee shall consist of the baseball Group Leader, Rating committee chairperson, Instructional chairperson and the designated CIF Baseball assignor.
